REGISTRATION

Registration for the 2019 CCA Spring Conference is now open. Please visit the conference website at [2019 Spring Conference Registration](#) to access the online registration and other conference information.

LODGING

You must make your own hotel reservations at the Hilton Irvine/Orange County Airport Hotel (1880 MacArthur Boulevard, Irvine, CA 92616) prior to ***April 11, 2019***, to receive the CCA negotiated rate. The CCA negotiated room rate with the Hilton is:

\$125 (plus applicable taxes) per night for single or double occupancy

Please make your own hotel reservations [online](#) or call Central Reservations at **(949) 812-3725** and refer to **CTA19** to receive the CCA negotiated rate.

To guarantee a room, you must supply a valid credit card number. Delegate lodging expenses will be reimbursed by CCA according to its Bylaws. CCA will pay one-half the cost of a double-occupancy room. Each delegate is expected to share a room with another delegate. Delegates wishing a single room must pay the difference between a double and single room except in extenuating circumstances. Prior authorization is required. **PLEASE NOTE: Delegates Must Attend All Sessions To Be Eligible For Lodging Reimbursement.** Delegates are responsible for paying the hotel bill upon checkout.

**REMINDER – HOTEL RESERVATIONS MUST BE MADE PRIOR TO APRIL 11, 2019,
TO RECEIVE THE CCA NEGOTIATED RATE.**

DELEGATES

NON-DELEGATE PARTICIPATION/INCENTIVE GRANTS

Pursuant to Standing Rule 2-2, ... CCA will reimburse the higher number of four participants at CCA conferences or the number of delegates allocated to the chapter as specified in the Bylaws. If a chapter is allocated less than four delegates, the remaining participants will attend as non-delegates. For non-delegates not covered by CCA Standing Rules, registration fees are \$300.

TRANSPORTATION

The nearest airport to the Hilton Irvine/Orange County Airport Hotel is the John Wayne Orange County Airport (SNA), which is one block from the hotel. The hotel provides complimentary shuttle service to/from the John Wayne Orange County Airport.

Discounted Overnight Self-Parking is \$12 per day and includes in and out privileges. Daily Commuter Self-Parking is \$12 per day with no in and out privileges.

CONFERENCE DELEGATE MEALS
