# TIMELINES CALENDAR AND PROCEDURES FOR ELECTION OF CTA STATE COUNCIL REPRESENTATIVE

The dates below represent the deadlines for the election of a CTA State Council Representative and/or Alternate. Chapter Presidents are responsible for distributing the information to all members in the chapter.

## **September 4** CCA HE Chairperson announces to CCA Chapter Presidents that:

- a. Nominations are now open for a representative for Multiples HE-8.
- b. Election of the State Council Representative will be determined by majority vote and Alternate will be determined by runner up
- c. Candidates must complete a Declaration of Candidacy form with an optional 30-word biographical sketch.

# **September 30** CCA MEMBERS:

- a. Return properly completed Declaration of Candidacy form with biographical statement to CCA HE.
- b. Forms must be received in the CCA HE Office no later than 5:00 p.m., Friday, September 30, 2020.

#### October 1 CCA HIGHER EDUCATION OFFICE:

a. Prepares and email the ballots. Names on the ballot will be listed in the order of the current CTA alphabet.

#### October 1–15 CCA MEMBER:

- a. Members may vote online through October 15th.
- b. All paper ballots that were requested must be returned by October 15<sup>th</sup> 2020.

### October 16-17th CCA HE ELECTIONS COMMITTEE:

- a. Compiles election totals from Simply Voting; and
- b. Notifies CCA HE Chairperson of completion of the election results.

## October 18th CCA HE Chairperson:

- a. Sends announcement of results to Chapter Presidents, Candidates and CTA Committee on Elections and Credentials; and
- c. Files ballots and official tally sheets for one year from date of election.

Challenges must be <u>received</u>, in writing, within 10 days after results are posted. Challenges should be sent to the CCA Elections Chair at elections@cca4us.org..
