Fall – Bargaining

The Fall Conference is held in early October and is dedicated to enhancing bargaining skills and coordinating strategies focused on collective bargaining. In addition to sessions on bargaining-related issues, we have our first Council meeting of the academic year. Generally, Legislative updates will also be offered at the Fall Conference. The Fall Conference also features our CCA California Leadership Academy or CCA Building Strong Locals Academy Graduations.

Winter – Advocacy

The Winter Conference is held in mid-February. The Winter Council highlights Advocacy in addition to lobbying and contract enforcement issues. We also offer one of the following Academies at our Winter Conference: Bargaining or Grievance. Generally, Legislation pertaining to Community Colleges will also be addressed. There is no Council meeting at the Winter Conference.

Spring – Membership/Member Engagement
